Financial Assistance Sources for Connection Expenses to Lake Carey Sewer Collection

Income limits are as follows for the USDA/RUS 502/504 Loan/Grant Program in Wyoming County

1-4 Person household, total income must fall below \$35,850 5-8 Person household total income must fall below \$47.350

- Applicants must own and reside in the home;
- For a grant, the applicant must be 62 years or older and not have ability to repay the loan;
- Maximum loan is \$40,000 and can be repaid over 20 years @ 1% interest;
- Maximum grant has a lifetime limit of \$10,000;
- Loans and grants can be combined for up to \$50,000;
- If applicants can repay part but, not all of the costs, USDA may offer a loan/grant combination.

- Connection Fee is \$3000.00 (this included 50 ft from Main line to your grinder pump. Any footage over 50 ft is \$24 per lineal foot) Include a copy of the invoice
- · Written estimate for Electrician to hook up
- Written estimate for a plumber to connect to your home line
- Written estimate for digging the trench from grinder pump to house sewer
- Written estimate or invoice to pump your existing on-lot septic
- Written estimate to have on-lot septic filled
