Flushing connections – repaired three and go back and repair and see if there are any other damages.

Grinder pumps for Kissal and Pasternak – costs to direction drill going to be more than original cost. Discuss how to bill those. Doug Smith to gather the total cost to get them in.

25 Shore Drive discussion. If the systems failed it has to connect. And septic system redesign.

14 Glowatch – haven't had a chance to get back. – grinder was too high for them to hook up. Dave Smith will go up.

Robic property - letter sent to ERA Brady.

Scada support quote discussion.

LDG – brief discussion regarding sending them a letter about deficiencies items

DEP planning for backyard extensions – approving them to other.

Nutrient offsets – still reviewing houses for nitrogen credits
